Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

In the joint advisory of the Philippine Pediatric Society (PPS) and the Philippine Infectious Disease Society of the Philippines (PIDSP) in December 2, 2020, the health experts have the following to say regarding SARS-CoV-2 infection in children and adolescents:

“... children and adolescents are susceptible to and can transmit SARS-CoV-2. They are primarily infected via close contact with people infected with the virus. There is some evidence that children with COVID-19 are capable of transmitting the virus to adults and other children. While COVID-19 in children usually presents with mild symptoms, some develop severe and critical disease requiring hospitalization with others resulting to death.”


In December 2020, the Metro Manila Council which include the city mayors of Metro Manila as members has voted unanimously not to follow the easing of age restrictions on those who are allowed to leave their homes. Minors less than 18 years old are not allowed to leave their homes; however, they are allowed to leave their homes for parent-supervised exercise-related activities around their neighborhood and for medical consultations and treatment. The age restrictions are still in effect in the city of Parañaque.

Because of this, we are reminding parents and guardians not to bring their infants, children and adolescents with them whenever they have business transactions here in Manresa School. Please leave them with a caretaker at home whenever you leave the house. If you bring them with you, you need to have an adult to accompany them in the car, parking area or waiting area while you are inside the campus. Leaving minors alone in your car, parking area or waiting area may expose them to security and health risks.


The restrictions imposed by quarantine guidelines has limited the consultations in our clinic to teleconsultations for students with medical problems. Let us continue to help each other in keeping our homes and community free from COVID-19.


